

#### **Community Broadband Internet Survey**

Is your internet access reliable and affordable? The City of Bellingham is currently conducting an analysis of internet resources for our residents. Your responses will help contribute to a <u>5-year comprehensive plan</u> (<u>External link</u>) to better assess the community's needs and obtain additional funding to expand our broadband network.

All Bellingham residents are invited to take the survey, regardless of current internet service or housing status. Residents who do not currently have an internet provider or access are also encouraged to take this survey. If you don't have internet access at home, you can take it at the Bellingham Public Library Central location by filling out a printed version.

We appreciate you taking the time to provide your input. The survey will take between 10-12 minutes of your time and is best taken while at your primary residence, and able to access your regular internet, if applicable.

The survey will close on February 6, 2024.

Bicycle registry services allow you to register your bike and its serial number in case it is ever stolen. You can add photos and detailed descriptions.
