**TOWN HALL MEETINGS:** The Bellingham City Council is hosting a series of town hall meetings to provide an opportunity for engagement between the community and the full City Council about timely issues facing our city. The next quarterly "Community Voices" town hall meeting is <u>November 14 – Community Voices on Affordable Housing (location TBD, link will be added when agenda is published)</u>

**PARKING REVISION:** Parking Removal for Bike and Pedestrian Upgrades: To make space for pedestrian and bicycle upgrades, some on-street parking will need to be removed for a few of the 2023 transportation projects recently approved by the Bellingham City Council in the 6-year Transportation Improvement Program. <u>Public hearing on parking removal for bike and pedestrians is on October 3, 2022 @ 7 pm</u>

**CONSOLIDATED PLAN:** Every five years, as a condition of receiving federal block grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the City is required to prepare a "Consolidated Plan". This Plan provides an assessment of the City's community development needs, and an analysis of the housing market for low-income households. It also presents the goals, strategies and specific activities that are implemented annually in order to address those needs. <u>Get involved and stay informed here</u>.
